Global Citizenship



What is it?

Global Citizen training is youth engagement through formal training, non-formal learning, capacity building and peer-based education. It is informed by the College's 50 year tradition of learner directed education which is at the centre of why partners work with us and what makes George Williams College almost unique.



The approach



The Global Citizenship Programme is a participatory, learner-centred led programme where participants share and build on their knowledge and experiences, engage as groups and active recipients, to focus on the global issues of the environment, economic engagement, health and well-being and civic engagement.

Participants engage in group discussions which compliment questions posed and encourages critical thinking and reflection. The overall experience of interactive, interdependent learning by its very nature enhances the social and personal skills of participants, promoting exploration values, attitudes and knowledge acquisition, while providing the means for those involved to generate and augment their practical capacities.

The learning process incorporates inclusive teaching and learning practices. Participants collaborate in building and strengthening their common values, while committing to appreciate and celebrate diversity. Cooperative analysis and problem-based learning provide exciting, innovate and engaging educational experiences.

The programme is designed to foster an evolving range of specific and connected competencies in an integrated manner. Participants will engage in group discussion which compliments questions posed questions to encourage critical thinking and reflection.

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Programme format

This is a project-based experience. To successfully complete the programme, you must complete:

Prior to YMCA175

2 weeks online programme, complete allocated tasks and work sheets in preparation for time together at YMCA175.

Face-to-face event

Attend sessions on Monday 5th, Tuesday 6th and Wednesday 7th of August 2019 at YMCA175, between 13:00 till 14:30 each day.

You will learn about:

- What is a Global Citizen and what makes for an active Global Citizenship
- How to communicate well as a Global Citizen
- The Global Citizenship lens – culture, economy, environment, history, politics, religion/faith, science, technology
- What makes us 'us'?

Cost

- £0 – non-accredited version. No assessment involved. You will be required to complete pre-programme reading and preparation
- £250 Level 2 (13 credits) accredited version – you must submit and pass all assessments:

Online work to be submitted Sept 30, 2019.

Project (2-3 months) Aim: Focusing on one identified global issue within your personal, local, national or global community; coordinate/run a community project in line with the discussions and learning from the online and intensive workshops.

Presentation the best way to represent the learning and results (e.g. written, visual, film, photographs, etc.) which incorporates all aspects of learning (lens, PLINs, communication etc.) to demonstrate a synthesis of learning.
